EXECUTIVE ORDER AFFECTS MANY HERE

President Wilson Issues Executive Order Extending Period of Trust as to Allotments for Ten Years, With Exceptions Among Ottawas, Senecas and Wyandottes, as Listed

The following is an order issued recently by President Wilson extending the trust periods on allotments which expire during the year 1917 for a period of ten years from date of expiration, with the exception of the following mentioned Ottawas, Senecas and Wyandottes:

EXECUTIVE ORDER.

It is hereby ordered, under authority contained in section 5 of the act of February 8, 1887 (24 Stat. L., 388-389), that the trust periods on the allotments of the Ottawa, Seneca, and Wyandotte Indians in Oklahoma, where the trust expires during the calendar year 1917, be, and is hereby, extended for a period of 10 years from the dates of expiration, with the exception of the following:
