A PDF of the NSDAR 2008 publication <u>Forgotten Patriots: African American and American Indian Patriots in the Revolutionary War</u> and a new supplement covering additions, corrections, and much more bibliographic information are both now available at the link below for free access and downloading.

The printed copies of the 2008 book sold out the middle of 2011, and we decided that we would prefer to make the publication available online for anyone interested at no cost. I've already started another supplement for 2012 onwards as our research in this subject area continues and as we watch for new publications, articles, dissertations, etc.
